Future challenges await this Exhibitor. They include at least three opportunities. First, by adding just one decade's worth of 'Offspring' to this collecting time frame, i.e. from 1990 to 2000, over 750 new 'Mother' stamps would become available for col-lecting. For example, the Columbian airmail on the right (whose 'Offspring' was not issued until 1995) could become part of a future exhibit:

Or, second, one might also attempt to add the following hard-to-find Mothers to the exhibit (an expensive proposition):







Lastly, one might simply focus on further completing the existing collection by adding, for example, this 'Mother' stamp from Guyana. Several years of searching have failed to turn it up. In my search for this bird issue, I have become acutely aware of the critical distinction between stamps that are rare and those that are scarce. So, which course to pursue? It is a decision best left for another day...
